As a promising high school quarterback in his senior year, Rader was diagnosed with Non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma. His dreams of playing college ball were shattered as he fought for his life. He beat cancer but was left with a serious opiate addiction that would haunt him for more than a decade. Now living drug free, Rader tells a story of addiction and redemption that is a cautionary tale from which anyone can learn.

Rader will be presenting to Jericho's tenth and eleventh grade students during the day and will return that night at 7 p.m. for a powerful parent presentation, including a discussion on how to identify the signs of addiction.
