Construction Underway On High School Track

Construction on the Jericho High School track, which commenced this week with demolition, will be completed in the spring of 2012.

As part of the total track renovation, the existing track will be removed and a reconfigured six lane rubberized track, according to the 400 Meter IAFF National Federation of State High School Association standards, will be built. This will allow for the football field to also be used for regulation soccer games. In addition, steeplechase, pole vault, long jump, high jump and triple jump will also be included in the new design.

“The football field and track will be off limits and considered a construction zone until work is completed in the spring,” said Tim Almeida, Director of Building and Grounds.
