



Spanish Honor Society's First Meeting! Candidates for induction: Fall 2012



Please read the following FAQs carefully before deciding to join the Spanish Honor Society:

1) Is there a grade requirement for this club?

Yes, you must have an A- final average or better for each of the following years: (8th, 9th, and 10th grade).

2) When does induction take place?

October of your Junior year (or in rare cases, October of your Senior year).

3) How much of a commitment is this club?

In order to be inducted into Spanish Honor Society in the fall of next year you must have earned 85% or more participation points by the end of this school year.

There will be **many** opportunities for you to earn points, but it is your responsibility to manage your time and choose which events, contests, drives you will participate in.

PLEASE NOTE THAT 85% MEANS THAT YOU HAVE PARTICIPATED IN THE VAST MAJORITY OF EVENTS AND DRIVES.

4) What if I cannot reach 85% of points this year due to conflicts, other responsibilities, etc.?

Points will carry over to the next school year giving you a chance to make up points over the next school year. If you reach 85% at that point, you will be inducted at the next fall ceremony.

(If you are a junior joining this year, you will have to make sure you earn enough points this year in order to be inducted in your senior year).

5) How do I earn points?

Points are awarded for participation in charity drives, contests, and school events.

We will keep records, but if you say that our records are incorrect then you must produce the card provided to you with a signature/stamp next to each point earned as proof of our mistake. This card is your receipt and proof of participation. **DO NOT LOSE THIS CARD.**

*****SO** at events and drives officers will be checking your participation and inserting points in the grade book. If you know you participated in an event or drive and don't see your point you may show the card to an officer so they may correct the mistake. **We will not change our records without this proof.**

4) How will I know when future events or drives will take place?

As of Friday, October 21st, 2011 you will have access to Spanish Honor Society through the Clubs and Functions folder on Edline. It is your responsibility to check Edline to see when and where these drives or events will take place! Emails will be sent by officers periodically to remind you of upcoming events. **Check your emails!** If you are unsure if your Edline works or whether your email account is linked to Edline you **MUST** see Leighanne Duncley in room 262.

You will not be able to see the club on Edline until your account is activated and officers have added you to the list of candidates. (Friday October 21st, 2011)

5) Who do I contact if I have any questions about events, drives, participation, etc.?

After checking Edline for information, if you still have questions, you can email any of the officers by clicking on their names. Please allow time for them to get back to you. Do not leave important questions to the last minute and expect them to return your email immediately.
