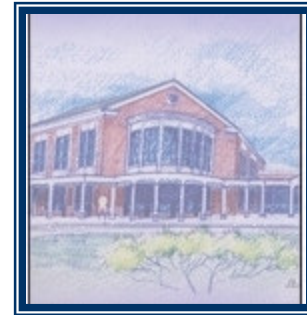

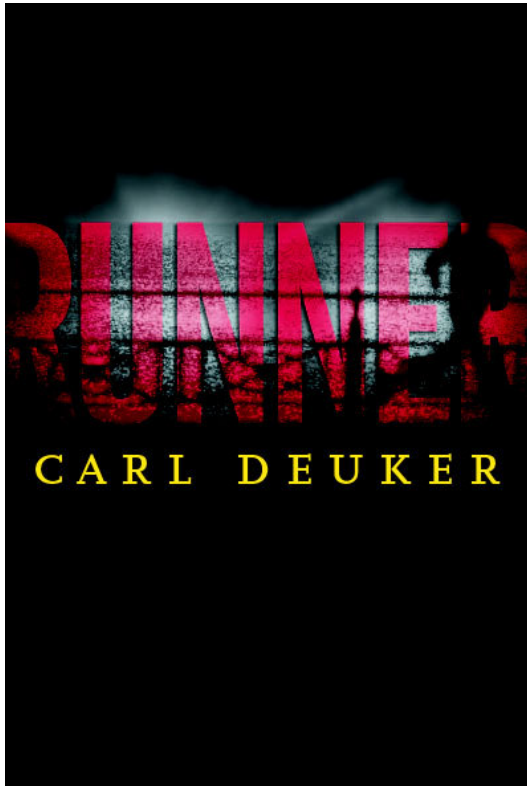


Reader's Advisory - Sports theme

Runner

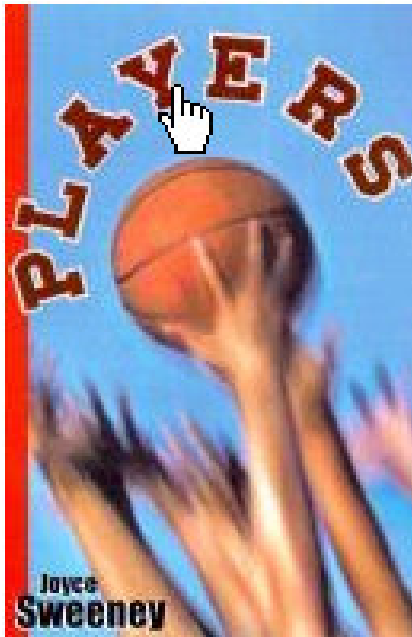
by Carl Deuker

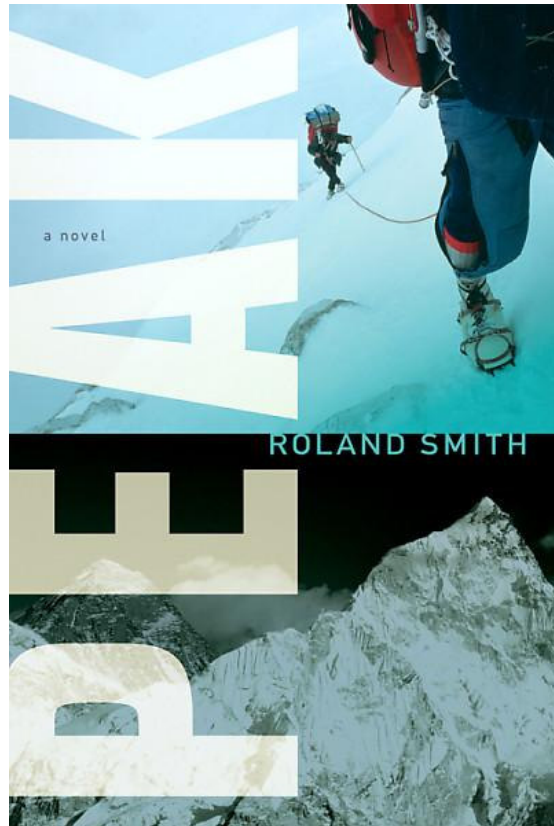
Hoops

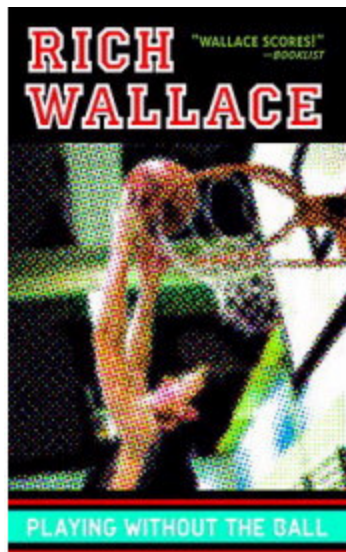
Peak

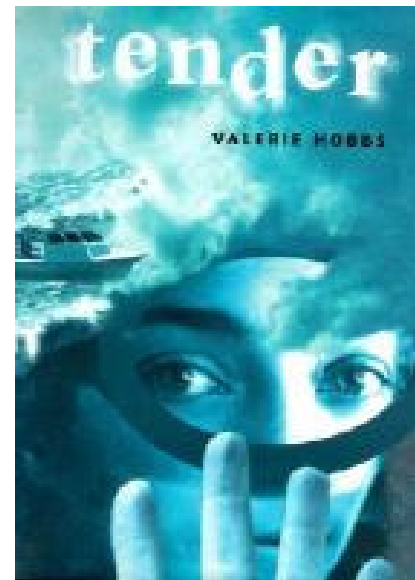

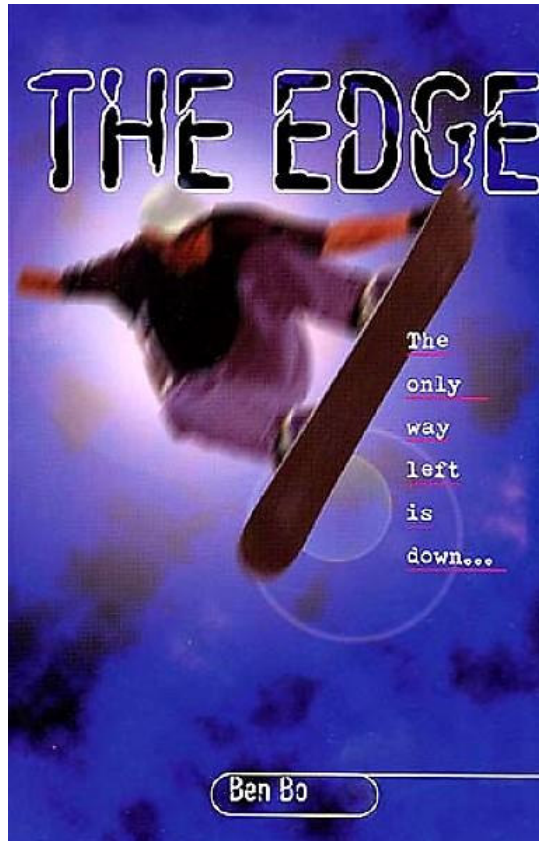
by Valerie Hobbs

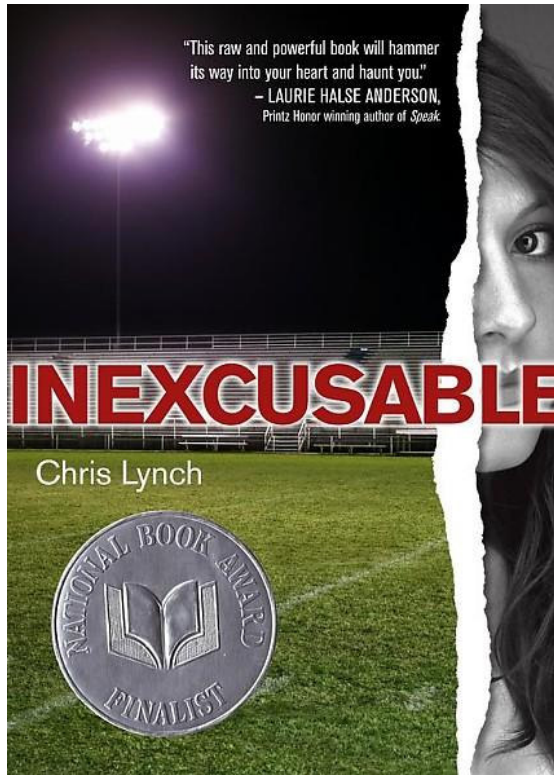
The Edge by Ben Bo

Three Clams and an Oyster

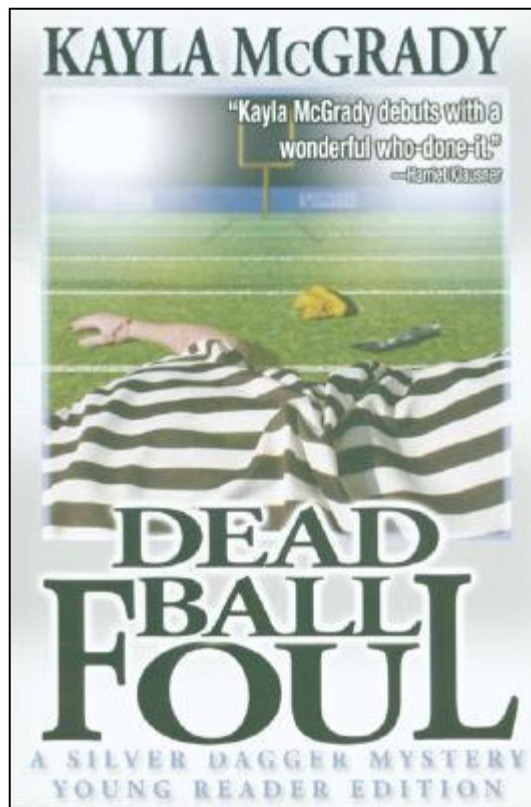

Four teens from a quiet town in Southwest Virginia work together to find a killer after one of their close friends is found murdered.

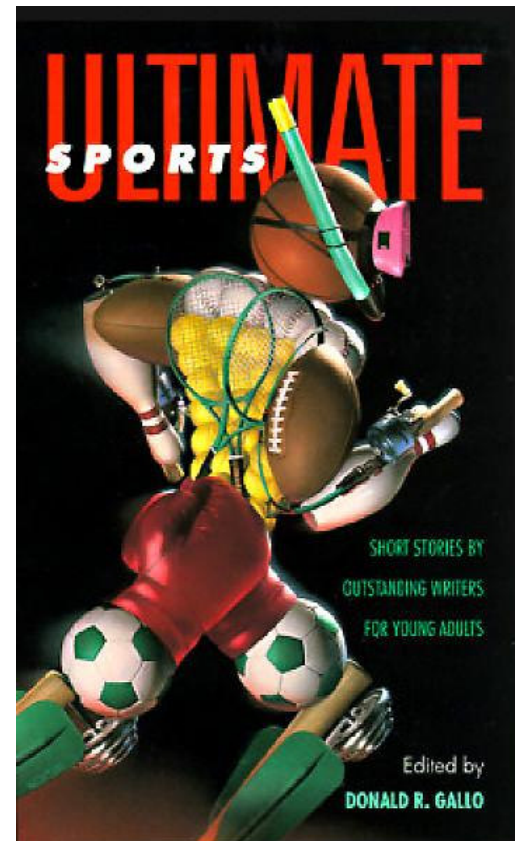

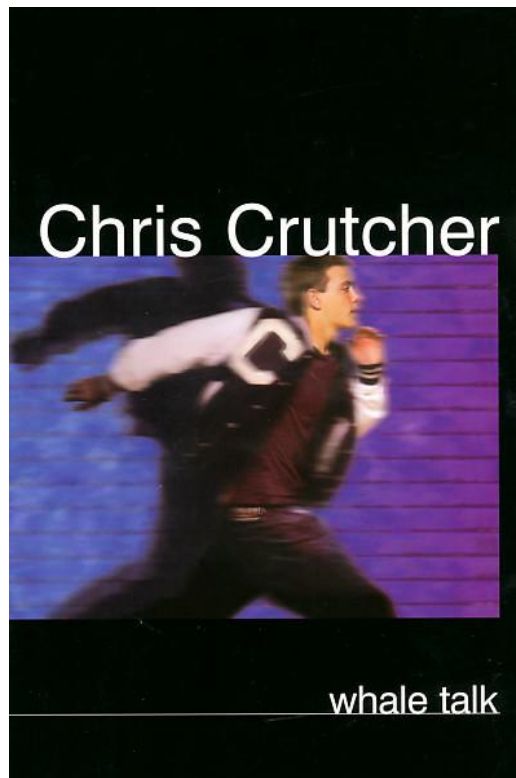
Ultimate Sports
