# Revolutionary War Baseball Card Project

From the list below, choose one Revolutionary War individual and design a baseball card for that person. The card should be the size of the poster, therefore larger than a standard baseball card.

The **front** of the card should be a drawing (no pictures printed from the internet please) of the person you chose which clearly identifies the individual. Drawing the individual in baseball attire is strongly recommended. Since the project is to create a baseball card, you **must** also make up a creative team name on the front as well. Team names should incorporate a Revolutionary War theme or something specifically associated with your Revolutionary War figure. **Example:** The Revolutionary Renegades (you may not use this)

On the **back** of the card include a brief biography of your individual and a detailed description of your players' role in the American Revolution. This must all be in your own words. Proper spelling, grammar, and sentence structure apply.

- ✓  I have included an accurate bibliography with at least 2 book sources and 2 internet sources on the back of my card
- ✓  My grammar, spelling, and sentence structure are correct
- ✓  My card is colorful and creative!! 😊
