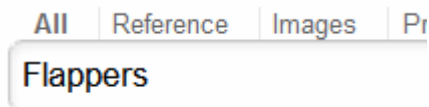


Gale Student Resources in Context: contains primary documents, biographies, full-text coverage of over 1,000 magazines and newspapers.
